
## ANIMAL LIMBS


The outer outline of the animal's limbs, I noticed the legs and ears that tremble when it faces difficulties.

#### CHAIN IN THE HEART

A chain is added to the symbol to connect the two outline parts of the heart. This represents the emotional bond between each other, and at the same time it is a kind of bondage.

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#### MECHANICAL STRUCTURES

Use metallic materials such as aluminium alloy or plastic to create the exoskeleton structure of half a robotic arm. Add a bionic design to the mechanical structure to simulate the shape of the bones and joints of the hand to give the whole a more organic feel.





#### MOVABLE JOINT DESIGN

Integrate movable joints so that the parts of the robotic arm can mimic the natural movement of a human arm.

#### MATERIAL

For the top half rigid white pique, choose a white pique with a hard texture to simulate a mechanical and technological feel. This stiff fabric creates the look of a mechanical device while giving a strong industrial and technological feel.








#### MATERIAL

The lower half of the yarn and ruffles design uses lightweight gauze or similar materials to mimic the soft texture of feathers through ruffles and layering.















#### MECHANICAL

Utilise metallic clothing elements, such as rivets, to highlight a sense of mechanics.

Embedding bionic designs, such as patterns or lines of mechanical devices, in clothing to highlight the contrast between the human body and machines.

#### THE FUSION OF MAN AND ANIMAL

Blending parts of the human body with animal elements, such as designing the hem of a skirt in the shape of a feather.




#### TRANSFORMATIONS AND CONVERSIONS


Designing transformable garments that can be switched between human and animal, human and mechanical by means of zips and buttons. The use of detachable elements allows for quick transitions between different parts of the garment, presenting the possibility of multiple identities.














#### SILHOUETTES




The fusion of human and animal silhouettes symbolises their closely intertwined relationship in life.













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
